

New for 2007, the Antique Brass Single Cone shares most of its features with our Vintage Steel Delphi, the difference being the finish on the body, coverplate, and tailpiece. These components are brass plated and finished in an aged patina to give this instrument an antique look. The hard rock maple neck has an ivoroid bound rosewood fingerboard, slotted headstock and vintage-style tuning machines.



New for 2007, the Antique Brass Tricone shares most of its features with our Vintage Steel Tricone, the difference being the finish on the body, coverplate, and tailpiece. These are brass plated and finished in an aged patina to give this instrument an antique look. The hard rock maple neck has an ivoroid bound rosewood fingerboard and 30's style peghead with vintage-style tuning machines.



Designed in collaboration with Mike Dowling, this single cone guitar is patterned after the famous El Trovador produced from 1932-1933. Similar to its predecessor, our El Trovador guitar features a large, 4" deep body constructed of mahogany. The body is bound in multi-layer celluloid, with a matching purfling border around the coverplate. A wood soundwell houses the resonator. An ebony fretboard is mated to a solid mahogany neck, capped with a rosewood headstock overlay. The El Trovador's deep, unique voice has made it our most popular guitar in recent years.

Now offered in a 12 string, our El Trovador guitar features a large, 4" deep body constructed of mahogany. The body is bound in multi-layer celluloid, with a matching purfling border around the coverplate. A wood soundwell houses the resonator. An ebony fretboard is mated to a solid mahogany neck, capped with a rosewood headstock overlay.



The Baritone El Trovador guitar features a large, 4" deep body constructed of mahogany. Tuned C to C standard from the factory, this 27" scale instrument caters to those who need lower tunings. The neck has slightly larger profile than the standard El Trovador and uses a heavier gauge set of strings. Tuners are vintage-style engraved, open gear. A wood soundwell houses the resonator. An ebony fretboard is mated to a solid mahogany neck, capped with a rosewood headstock overlay. The El Trovador's deep, unique voice has made it our most popular guitar in recent years.

Tuners are vintage-style engraved, open gear.



This rich looking concert ukulele comes with a figured koa top, back and sides. The neck is made of figured mahogany with an unbound rosewood fingerboard. The headstock has a tortoise/ivoroid overlay. This instrument shown with optional rope binding.



Back by popular demand, the M-2 is the second generation of the National Reso-Phonic M-1 made from 1990-1994. An M-2's body is composed of laminate top and back, and solid mahogany sides. This instrument also features a mahogany neck with engraved pearloid headstock overlay, rosewood fretboard and mother-of-pearl position markers. Tuners are vintage-style engraved, open gear



This Concert Ukulele comes with a mahogany top, back and sides. The neck is made of mahogany with an unbound rosewood fingerboard. The headstock has a tortoise/ivoroid overlay to complete this instrument.



This Concert Ukulele comes with a figured maple top, back and sides. The neck is made of figured maple with an unbound rosewood fingerboard. The headstock has a tortoise/ivoroid overlay to complete this instrument.



The first of our spider bridge wood body guitars, the Model D was introduced by National Reso-Phonic in 2000.

A walnut top is complemented by conventional screened sound-hole rings and traditional coverplate. The sides are solid walnut, and a walnut laminate is used for the back. The standard Model D is a square neck with a flat lined fretless ebony fingerboard. It is also available with a round neck.

The distinctive Western Model D has a figured maple top, solid walnut sides and an exotic quarter-matched walnut burl back. The top and back of the body, as well as the fingerboard, are bound with maple/rosewood "rope" binding. The standard square neck is walnut with a lap-style flat ebony fingerboard inlaid with white mother-of-pearl arrow markers. The headstock is overlaid with white pearloid into which the National logo has been engraved. This guitar comes equipped with vintage-style, open gear, three-on-a-plate tuners. The coverplate, removable strap, and tailpiece are plated in satin nickel.



Our new NRP model captures the look and feel of an original 12 fret National Duolian. The thin-gauge steel body is highlighted by flat cut "f" holes, a formed back, and period-correct, traditional non-ribbed coverplate. Each body is hand painted to capture the look of the originals. Each mahogany neck clears 12 frets to the body and features an unbound ebony fretboard complete with mother-of-pearl position markers. Vintage-style plain tuners, ebony nut, and "National" stamped headstock complete the look this classic. body and features ivoroid binding and traditional engraved tuners. Tuners are vintage-style engraved, open gear.



Our new NRP-14 fret model captures the look and feel of an original 14 fret National Duolian. The thin-gauge steel body is highlighted by rolled "f" holes, a formed back, and period-correct, traditional ribbed coverplate. Each body is hand painted to capture the look of the originals. Each mahogany neck clears 14 frets to the body and features an unbound ebony fretboard complete with mother-of-pearl position markers. Vintage-style plain tuners, ebony nut, and "National" stamped headstock complete the look this classic.



The NRP Tricone borrows many of its features from our single cone NRP guitar. The body is made from thingauge steel and has a formed back. Each is carefully hand painted at our factory in San Luis Obispo, Ca. A maple neck clears 12 frets to the body and features an ivoroid-bound rosewood fretboard complete with inlaid mother-of-pearl position markers. Tuners are vintage-style engraved, open gear.



We now offer a wood body version of our new NRP guitar. Each maple-laminate body is hand painted with matching steel coverplate. A mahogany neck clears 12 frets to the body and features an unbound ebony fretboard complete with mother-of-pearl position markers. Vintage-style plain tuners, ebony nut, and "National" stamped headstock highlight the unique look of this wood body guitar.



The Reso Jr. II was designed from the ground up as a simplified version of the Resolectric. It incorporates a Jason Lollar single coil pickup with passive volume and tone controls. This instrument has a solid beech wood body with inlaid black/white/black purfling. The hard rock maple neck has an unbound rosewood fretboard with ivoroid position markers. The solid angled headstock has a unique shape accentuated by Kluson closed gear tuners.



The Reso Jr. II Sunburst was designed from the ground up as a simplified version of the Resolectric. It incorporates a Jason Lollar single coil pickup with passive volume and tone controls. This instrument has a solid beech wood body with inlaid black/white/black purfling. The hard rock maple neck has an unbound rosewood fretboard with ivoroid position markers. The solid angled headstock has a unique shape accentuated by Kluson closed gear tuners. This instrument incorporates a striking sunburst that sets it apart from the blonde Reso Jr II.



Our Resolectric has gone through a few changes in its 19 years of production. The current model uses an audiophile-quality Highlander preamp to mix both the magnetic and piezoelectric pickups. A Jason Lollar P-90 pickup sits in the neck position, and a Highlander piezo transducer is fitted under the saddle. The output of each pickup is controlled by independent volume knobs, with a master volume knob to control the instrument's overall output level. A 3-way toggle switch selects which pickups are active. The solid mahogany body is capped with a figured maple top bound in ivoroid. The figured maple neck clears 14 frets to the body, highlighted with a diamond inlaid, rosewood fretboard.



The ResoRocket is one of our newly designed single resonator guitars. This model incorporates a redesigned coverplate pattern to complement the distinctive Tricone-style grill work. The upper bout has been modified for easier access to the higher frets. This brass body guitar is highly polished and bright nickel plated. The maple neck has an engraved pearloid headstock overlay and mother-of-pearl diamond position markers.



Our new mandolin spent two years in R&D before finally making it into production in January of 2005. It has traditional features such as a biscuit bridge and vintage-style open gear tuners, combined with modern appointments, including an intonated saddle and a comfortably radiused, extended fretboard. The neck is made from highly figured maple. The body is carved from two-piece walnut, with a figured maple top. The Art-Deco cast tailpiece and antique brass parts are exclusive to this instrument.



The Style 1.5 is a slightly upgraded version of our Style 1. A hand-engraved, double-cut wriggle pattern borders the top, sides, and back of the body. The position markers have been upgraded to mother-of-pearl diamonds. It has an engraved ivoroid headstock overlay with a matching heel cap.



New for 2008, the Style 1 Don features many of the specifications of its 1934 counterpart. This is our first instrument which uses authentic Nickel Silver (German Silver) as the material for the body. The double cut diamond engraving pattern, ribbed sieve-hole coverplate, and the decorative "DON" engraved handstrap reproduce the look of the originals. The mahogany neck clears 14 frets to the body and features an ivoroid bound ebony fretboard complete with inlaid mother-of-pearl position markers. The slotted headstock is overlaid with engraved pearloid and comes standard with Waverly, three-on-a-plate tuners. This limited edition instrument will be accompanied by an official letter of Authenticity certifying it as one of the one hundred instruments that will be built.



Our Style 1 Tricone shares many of its' features with the original National Tricone created by the Dopyera brothers in the late 1920's. The brass body is polished to a mirror-like shine and nickel plated. The mahogany neck, finished in a rich mahogany burst, has an ivoroid bound ebony fingerboard. The vintage-style tuning machines sit on a traditional slotted headstock, complete with our distinctive National shield decal.



Our Baritone guitar was designed in collaboration with Bob Brozman. Tuned C to C standard from the factory, this 27" scale instrument caters to those who need lower tunings. The cones, body, and aluminum T-bridge remain standard. The neck has slightly larger profile than the standard Style 1 and uses a heavier gauge set of strings. Tuners are vintage-style engraved, open gear.



This Cutaway Tricone is a modern shift on the classic Tricone design. The body has been modified to allow access to the higher frets. The body, coverplate, and tailpiece sport the same nickel-plated body as its Style 1 predecessor.



Our Style 1 Tricone is now available in "German Silver". This material, used for the body and coverplate, is the same alloy used by the Dopyera Brothers to create the first National Tricone guitars in the late 1920's. The body, coverplate, and tailpiece are polished to a mirror-like shine and nickel plated. The mahogany neck, finished in a rich mahogany burst, has an ivoroid bound ebony fingerboard. The vintage-style tuning machines sit on a traditional slotted headstock, complete with the National shield decal.



The Style 2 is hand-engraved with the "Wild Rose" design on the body, coverplate, and handrest. The position markers have been upgraded to mother-of-pearl diamonds. The mahogany neck has an engraved ivoroid headstock overlay with a matching heel cap.



The Style 2 Ukulele is hand-engraved with the "Wild Rose" design on the body, coverplate, and handrest. The position markers have been upgraded to mother-of-pearl diamonds. The ebony headstock overlay has an inlaid mother-of-pearl engraved National shield.



The intricate "Lily of The Valley" design is individually hand-engraved throughout the Style 3 Tricone. The position markers are mother-of-pearl diamonds. The mahogany neck has an engraved ivoroid headstock overlay with a matching heel cap.



Each Style 3 Single Cone guitar is hand engraved with the "Lily of The Valley" design. Featuring a highly figured maple neck with a diamond inlaid ebony fretboard. The fretboard binding, heel cap, and headstock overlay are made of ivoroid. An engraved shield and double-cut border adorn the headstock.





It is constructed with the famous "German Silver" alloy, which is the same material used to build the National Style N's of the late 1920's. The body, coverplate, and tailpiece are highly polished and nickel plated. A traditional sunburst maple neck is bound in ivoroid and fitted with our vintage-style engraved tuners



Another new guitar for 2009, the German Silver Style N-14 is a world class instrument. It is constructed with the famous "German Silver" alloy, which is the same material used to build the National Style N's of the late 1920's. The body, coverplate, and tailpiece are highly polished and nickel plated. A traditional sunburst maple neck is bound in ivoroid and fitted with our vintage-style engraved tuners



Our flagship model, the Style O recreates the look and feel of the original 1930's single resonator guitars.

This brass bodied instrument is polished to a mirror-like shine, nickel plated, and finally etched with the distinctive Hawaiian palm tree design. The maple neck is finished in a traditional sunburst. An ivoroid bound ebony fretboard and vintage-style engraved tuners complete the look of this timeless classic.



The Style O Deluxe is an enhanced version of our most popular model, the Style O. A hand-engraved wriggle pattern, with double cut lines, borders the body and coverplate. Position markers have been upgraded to mother-of-pearl diamonds. The neck material has been upgraded to figured maple with an engraved ivoroid headstock overlay and matching heel cap. Tuners are vintage-style engraved, open gear.



The Style O Deluxe Ukulele is an enhanced version of our Style O Uke. A hand-engraved wriggle pattern, with double cut lines borders the body and coverplate. The position markers have been upgraded to mother-of-pearl diamonds. The ebony headstock overlay has an inlaid mother-of-pearl engraved National shield.



Each Replicon begins its life as a Style O. The instrument then goes through a distress and aging process to make it look and feel as if it were 75 years old. The metal parts are artificially aged for the look of a lifetime's worth of use. The neck is artificially worn for a "broken-in" feel.



Our fine Style O Ukulele is based on the original National Ukuleles of the 1930's. The traditional Hawaiian palm tree design is etched on the top and back, with a stripe around the sides. This instrument comes with a 15" concert scale length and Grover friction tuners.



Our reproduction Style O-14 Fret meets the demands of players needing easier access to the higher frets. Based on the original 1937 model, the hard rock maple neck clears 14 frets to the body. The brass body is made of thin gauge material polished to a mirror-like shine, nickel plated and etched with the traditional Hawaiian scene. The "chicken-foot" coverplate, formed back, and inlaid rosewood peghead complete the authentic look of this guitar.



Introduced in 2009, our new Triolian is a reissue of an early 1930's W-Series Triolian. The thin-gauge steel body is highlighted by flat cut "f" holes, a formed back, and traditional sieve-hole coverplate. Each body is hand painted in walnut-burst to capture the look of the originals. The maple neck clears 12 frets to the body and features an ivoroid-bound rosewood fretboard complete with inlaid mother-of-pearl position markers.



New for 2009, our Triolian 14-Fret captures the look and feel of the late 1930's W-Series Triolians. By popular demand, we have recently introduced the Triolian Polychrome. Each instrument has been carefully hand painted to match the look of the original Polychrome Triolians of the early 1930's, including the detailed palm tree design on the back. The thin-gauge steel body is constructed with flat cut "f" holes, a formed back, and traditional non-ribbed coverplate. The maple neck, complete with maple fretboard, clears 12 frets to the body and features ivoroid binding and traditional engraved tuners. Tuners are vintage-style engraved, open gear.


